

ILTS Committee Spotlight: Anesthesia, Critical Care Committee

The ILTS Anesthesia and Critical Care Committee represents and recruits members in these specialties while promoting education, collaboration, and communication across the field. Its goals are to raise standards of perioperative care, improve outcomes, and contribute to the development of official ILTS clinical practice guidelines. The committee also fosters partnerships with related professional societies to advance shared objectives and strengthen multidisciplinary engagement. Reflecting ILTS's international spirit, members represent India, France, the UK, the USA, Canada, Ireland, and Spain. The committee is

currently led by Emmanuel Weiss (Chair), Michael Spiro (Vice Chair), Ashish Malik (Past Chair), and Fuat Saner and Dmitri Bezinover (Affiliated Council Members).

The Anesthesia and Critical Care Committee had an exceptionally productive year, organizing scientific sessions at ILTS 2025 and contributing to the SATA/ILTS Perioperative Meeting. Members played key roles in the LDLTregistry.org collaboration, co-authoring two major American Journal of Transplantation papers on global disparities and outcomes in living donor liver transplantation. The registry, co-founded by Michael Spiro, now includes data from over 3,500 paired submissions and is open for spin-off studies worldwide. Another major milestone was the publication of the ILTS/LICAGE Guidelines for Cardiovascular Assessment Before Liver Transplantation (Am J Transplant, 2025), setting new perioperative care standards. The committee also enhanced internal communication through an active WhatsApp forum that supports rapid case discussion and collaboration. These initiatives reflect the committee's ongoing commitment to advancing education, clinical excellence, and research in perioperative liver transplant care.



Dra Nameyı Kwan Man Spotlight

At the University of Hong Kong, Professor Nancy Kwan Man and her Laboratory of Liver Transplantation and Liver Cancer continue to define global excellence in translational and clinical innovation. Her team's pioneering research has illuminated mechanisms of marginal graft injury, disease recurrence, and novel theranostic strategies in transplant oncology and immunology.

Growing up with ILTS

Their partnership with ILTS began over two decades ago, marked by their first Young Investigator Award in 2003. Since then, the team has nurtured a generation of scientists, recognized by a continuous series of ILTS Young Investigator Awards, Rising Star Awards and Vanguard Awards from 2003 through 2025. This demonstrates their sustained innovation and commitment to mentoring future leaders. This work culminated in Professor Man's ILTS Presidency (2018-2019), and her receipt of the Basic Science Established Investigator Award in 2022.

Innovation in Precision Oncology

Their groundbreaking "Liver-in-Cube" 3D-bioprinted drug screening platform—winner of the Geneva Gold Medal for Invention—along with advances in microrobotics and bioengineered liver tissue, showcases their leadership in precision medicine. Through their research and contributions to ILTS consensus guidelines, Professor Man's team continues to shape the science and future of liver transplantation worldwide.
